JOB DESCRIPTION

JOB TITLE: GENERAL MAINTENANCE

Supervisor: Director of Maintenance

Qualifications:

High School Diploma or GED

- Hold or qualify for General Maintenance according to WV Code
- Additional Minimum Requirements: Applicants who have recent unsatisfactory evaluations will not be considered
 eligible for consideration; applicants who demonstrate unsatisfactory interview performance are not eligible for
 consideration; and, applicants who receive unfavorable reference recommendations will not be eligible for
 consideration.
- Additional Minimum Requirements for Applicants Not Currently Employed: Applicants who have been dismissed or who have had their contracts non-renewed for cause by another school district are not eligible for consideration;
- The ability to perform the job duties and responsibilities of the position as contained in the Job Description, with or without reasonable accommodation

WV Code:

<u>General maintenance:</u> a person employed as a helper to skilled maintenance employees and to perform minor repairs to equipment and buildings of a county school system.

PERFORMANCE STANDARDS

Maintaining positive work habits

DUTIES/RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1. Assists in the construction and repair of cabinets, tables, bookcases and other school furniture.
- 2. Perform minor repairs to equipment and buildings.
- 3. Replace glass in windows, doors, cases, etc.
- 4. Repair and maintain general care of grounds.
- 5. Assist with masonry and associated carpentry tasks.
- 6. Assist in the repair and maintenance of roofs, gutters and flashing.
- 7. Perform painting tasks on school building and equipment.
- 8. Perform tasks related to the repair and maintenance of floor covering.
- 9. Assist in tasks related to the installation, repair and maintenance of the sanitation system in all school facilities.
- 10. Perform record keeping tasks associated with the position.
- 11. Perform tasks associated with the general maintenance of Board of Education vehicle.
- 12. Perform tasks related to cleaning of buildings and the operation and minor repair of heating, cooling and plumbing systems.
- 13. Assist in the tasks related to the minor repair of electrical systems.
- 14. Replace/repair door and related hardware.
- 15. Perform routine manual tasks in all areas of maintenance, including but not limited to:
 - Snow removal, cutting grass, digging holes/trenches, etc.
- 16. Perform other tasks determined as necessary for the effective, efficient and safe operation of the school system as assigned by the Director of Maintenance or his designee.
- 11. Participates in seminars and workshops in the areas of maintenance and custodial responsibilities. .
- 12. Participates in in-service programs conducted by the county.
- 13. Reads current articles relating to job assignments.
- 14. Accepts responsibility for the work assigned.
- 15. Accepts constructive criticism.
- 16. Exhibits a positive attitude toward assigned work.
- 17. Possess the physical/emotional health necessary for effective job performance.
- 18. Is receptive to the using of current practices as related to maintenance and custodial work.
- 19. Maintains appropriate appearance and personal hygiene.
- 20. Able to function under adverse physical conditions.
- 21. Be able to function as a contributing member of the maintenance crew.
- 22. Other duties as assigned by supervisor.
