

DRIVER EDUCATION VEHICLES

1.0 Definitions

- 1.1 A driver education vehicle shall be defined as any vehicle, which is primarily used to deliver driver training for students enrolled in a driver's education class.
- 1.2 Staff members shall include any full time regular employees of the Board.

2.0 General Policy Statement

- 2.1 Identification of Driver Education vehicle - Any vehicle being used for the purpose of driver education shall have visible identification to other drivers from all directions. It should indicate clearly that the car is being used for Driver Education and/or being operated by a student driver.
- 2.2 Use of Driver Education Vehicles — Driver education vehicles shall be used only for the teaching of driver education during the hours of the school day that the driver education program is scheduled. If the vehicle is used for any purpose other than driver education, any identification as a "Student Driver" or "Driver Education" shall either be covered or be removed. Driver education vehicles may be used for the following purposes with prior approval from the superintendent of schools.
 - 2.3 To transport staff members to approved professional development or training sessions.
 - 2.4 To transport students to school sponsored co-curricular or extracurricular events.
 - 2.5 Other uses as approved by the county superintendent of schools.

3.0 Review Schedule

This policy shall be reviewed in accordance with the Policy Review Schedule published by the Superintendent.
