## STUDENT GRADING SYSTEM POLICY

## 1.0 Purpose

The purpose of the student grading system policy is to communicate student progress in meeting the West Virginia & Grant County Schools' Content Standards and Objectives.

- **1.1** Grant County Schools expects each student to perform to the best of his/her ability. Each staff member will develop and maintain a climate that encourages and supports rigorous academic achievement and high standards of behavior.
- **1.2** Grant County Schools will provide all students with highly rigorous instructional programs, assignments, tests, projects, and other instructional activities designed to promote individual learning and measure individual student performance.

## 2.0 Responsibility

The West Virginia Department of Education along with Grant County Schools will determine Content Standards and Objectives that relate to the essential elements for grade level subjects and courses.

- **2.1** The Content Standards and Objectives will address skills needed for successful performance in the next grade or next course in a sequence of courses
- **2.2** On-site administrators and school personnel are directed to provide for and monitor an educational climate that encourages and supports individual academic achievement and high standards of behavior.

## 3.0 Procedures

The Superintendent is directed to establish administrative regulations for the purposes of promoting and ensuring fair and equitable grading practices in all Grant County schools.

- **3.1** The Superintendent is directed to take the Student Grading System Administrative Regulations before the Grant County Board of Education for annual review prior to August 15 of each school year.
- **3.2** A synopsis of the Student Grading System Administrative Regulations shall be published, along with this policy, in all student and faculty handbooks.
