
STUDENT GRADING SYSTEM POLICY

1.0 Purpose

The purpose of the student grading system policy is to communicate student progress in meeting the West Virginia & Grant County Schools' Content Standards and Objectives.

1.1 Grant County Schools expects each student to perform to the best of his/her ability. Each staff member will develop and maintain a climate that encourages and supports rigorous academic achievement and high standards of behavior.

1.2 Grant County Schools will provide all students with highly rigorous instructional programs, assignments, tests, projects, and other instructional activities designed to promote individual learning and measure individual student performance.

2.0 Responsibility

The West Virginia Department of Education along with Grant County Schools will determine Content Standards and Objectives that relate to the essential elements for grade level subjects and courses.

2.1 The Content Standards and Objectives will address skills needed for successful performance in the next grade or next course in a sequence of courses.

2.2 On-site administrators and school personnel are directed to provide for and monitor an educational climate that encourages and supports individual academic achievement and high standards of behavior.

3.0 Procedures

The Superintendent is directed to establish administrative regulations for the purposes of promoting and ensuring fair and equitable grading practices in all Grant County schools.

3.1 The Superintendent is directed to take the Student Grading System Administrative Regulations before the Grant County Board of Education for annual review prior to August 15 of each school year.

3.2 A synopsis of the Student Grading System Administrative Regulations shall be published, along with this policy, in all student and faculty handbooks.
