EXPECTATIONS OF APPROPRIATE BEHAVIOR And GOOD SPORTSMANSHIP

1.0 Purpose

The Grant County Board of Education recognizes the value of faculty, student, parent, and community attendance at school sponsored events. Examples of such events include athletic, band and choral competitions, District and individual school awards/honors banquets, PTO and LSIC meetings, etc. School sponsored events such as these, which embody a high standard of ethical behavior and sportsmanship, play a significant role in the development of good character and other important life skills in students.

In support of this notion, appropriate conduct, use of good manners, and good sportsmanship is an expectation of all event attendees at all times. Therefore, it is important that steps be taken to ensure that students, student-athletes, school employees, coaches, parents, community members and any & all visitors behave in a manner conducive to appropriate sportsmanship and excellent conduct at all school related and/or spectator events. Violation of school, county, West Virginia Secondary School Activities Commission (herein known as the WVSSAC), or state policy, or the breaking of any local, state or federal ordinance or law while in attendance at a school sponsored event may lead to the suspension or termination of attendance privileges, restriction of access to school property, or legal action.

Note: This policy shall not supersede the Student Code of Conduct and other applicable state or county policies.

Administrative Regulations

The Superintendent shall promulgate administrative guidelines to ensure the prompt and effective implementation of this policy.

Review Schedule

This policy shall be reviewed as determined by the Policy Review Schedule.
